BASIC INFORMATION

1. Students will audition on Saturday, October 22nd, 2011 at Jolliff Middle School in Chesapeake, VA. Audition times will be sent to your teacher by October 10th.
2. Due to the large number of students that will be auditioning, it will be impossible to schedule a specific audition time. In addition, all scheduled times will be subject to the unexpected variables of the day.
3. Students must audition for their respective grade level orchestra.
4. Your child must be scheduled in the school orchestra in order to audition.
5. Your child's teacher must be present at the event the entire day in order to audition.
6. The registration fee of \$5.00 along with this permission slip is due to your child's teacher by **October 1st**.
